**13 Members present**

- 1.) The meeting was called to order at 7:15pm
- 2.) The Secretary's report was read and accepted.
- 3.) The Treasurer's report was read and accepted.

Checking: \$1,740.93 Savings: \$6,694.08 Total: \$8,435.01  
Our biggest bill of the year has been paid (Insurance).

**Trailmasters:** We still need to cut the two trees that are down, the one by the high school and the one at the Little Sebago lake end of Libby Hill trail. Brad, Katie, and Barney finished up the trail to Julien's Restaurant. Brad, Bronc, and Barney also made an opening in the rock wall just before Mayall rd. and repaired the bridge enough so it is passable this winter. Jarod replaced some planking on the Merrill rd. bridge, this makes the trail from Gray Plaza all the way to the New Gloucester Pipeline off Morse Rd. ready to go. Brad and Jarod poled the Spring Meadows Golf Course on 12/2 but we left the gates up until there is more snowpack. Thanks to Bronc for acquiring the new poles for us.

**South Gray:**

Ask Jarod for a report. Bridge replaced behind plaza, thank you's to Jarod, Brad, Bronc, Barney, Alan, and Tim. Jarod mentioned all trails in South Gray are ready to go, including a new trail to Tailgates Restaurant. Permission was granted from Keith Harriman the property owner.

- 3.) Bronc acquired new poles for us to place on the Turf Farm and Spring Meadows

- 5.) Brad received the Ice Fishing permit from the State.
- 6.) Bill Murphy has submitted an application for our Poker Run, this is a new law that we just became aware of. Cost is \$25.

- 11.) **All drags and both widetracks are ready to go. Bronc and Terry can give an update on the Bombi.**
- 12.) **Brad made copies of the MSA Groomer Safety Course DVD. Anybody that groom's for our club needs to view the DVD and perform the test. Once you've completed it we send it in to the MSA which in turn scores it and certifies our groomer operators. This will be a requirement for all who wish to groom.**
- 13.) **We are out of lumber, if we have any other bridges that need to be replaced please let Brad or Jarod know so we can order more.**
